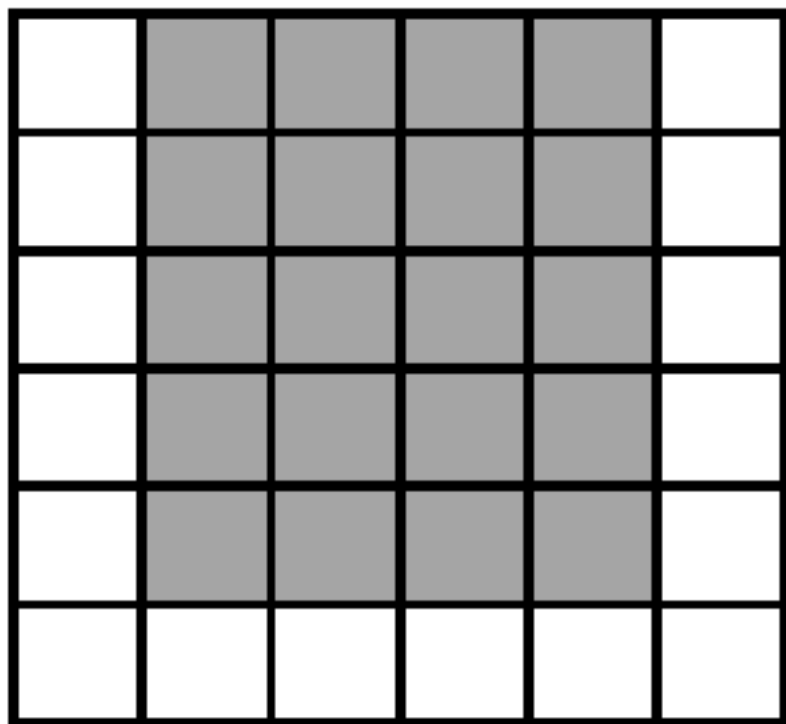



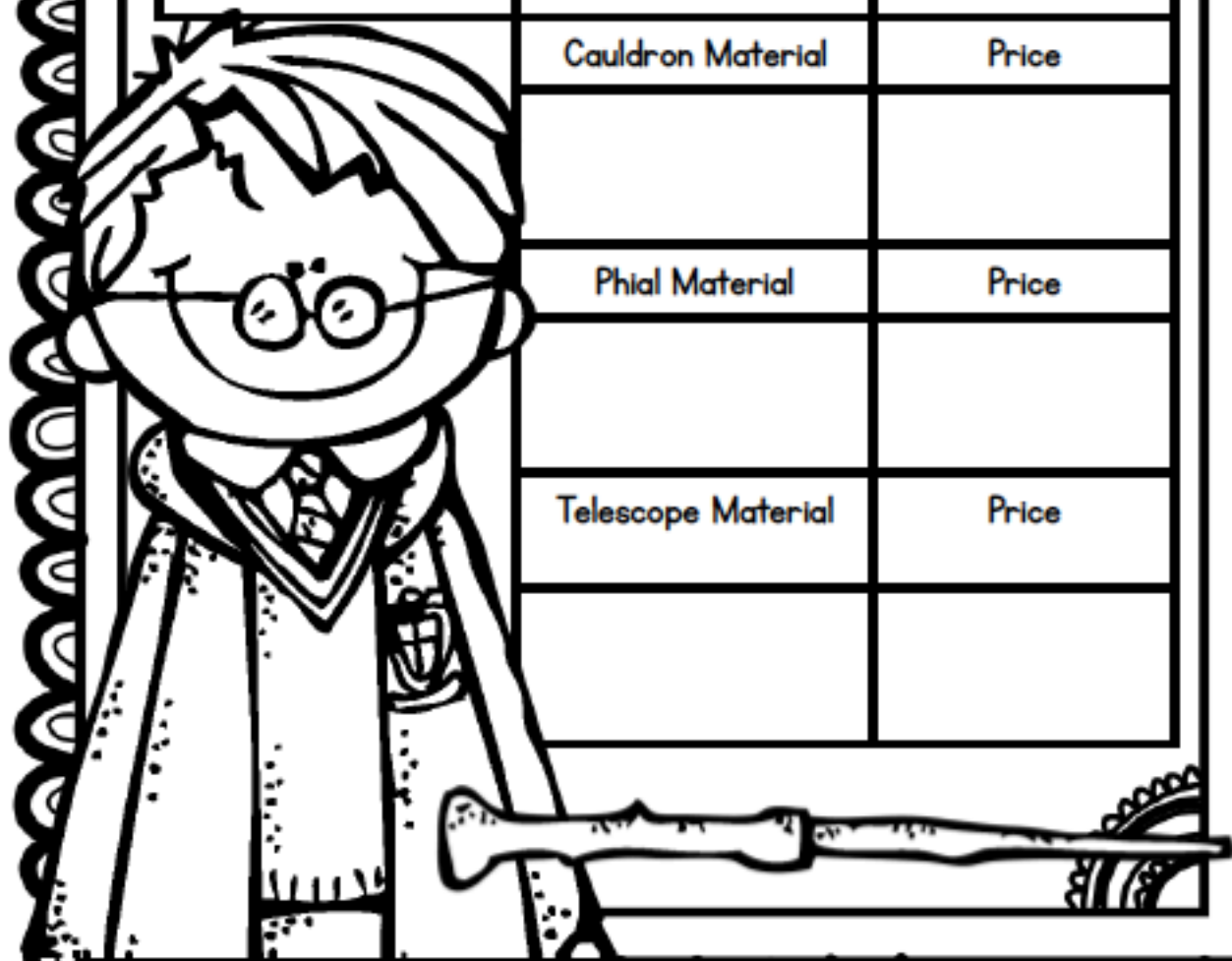

# I Can Solve Two-Step Problems

Now we are going to simplify our money amounts. Here is a list of money equivalents so that you can simplify your amounts.

29 Knuts = 1 Sickle

17 Sickles = 1 Galleon

Use the chart below to help you simplify. Add up how many of each type of coin you used in Diagon Alley. Then look to see if you can turn that into a different coin. For example, if you used 31 Knuts, you know that you can simplify that into 1 Sickle and 2 Knuts. (Think of it this way, you wouldn't pay for your new video game at the store with 3,000 pennies. You would use \$30.)
